SECTION 6: Accidental release measures

6.1 Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

It is recommended that emergency responders wear air-carrying respirators, anti-static clothing, and rubber oil-resistant gloves. Do not touch or step over spillage. All equipment used during work should be grounded. Cut off sources of leaks as much as possible. Eliminate all ignition sources. The warning area is delineated according to the influence area of liquid flow, vapor or dust diffusion, and unrelated personnel are evacuated to the safe area from the crosswind and upwind directions.

6.3 Methods and materials for containment and cleaning up

Quickly evacuate personnel from the contaminated area to a safe area and immediately isolate for 150m, with strict restrictions on entry and exit. It is recommended that emergency personnel wear self-contained positive pressure respirators and acid and alkali resistant work clothes. Do not come into direct contact with leaks. Cut off the source of leakage as much as possible. Small leakage: Absorb with sand, vermiculite, or other inert materials. Massive leakage: Build embankments or dig pits for containment. Clear under expert guidance.

7.1 Precautions for safe handling

Closed operation, fully ventilated. Prevent the release of steam and dust into the workshop air. Operators must undergo specialized training and strictly adhere to operating procedures. It is recommended that operators wear self priming filter type dust masks, chemical safety goggles, penetrating gas protective clothing, and chemical resistant gloves. Do not touch the skin, eyes, or clothing. Thoroughly clean after operation. Keep away from sparks and heat sources, and smoking is strictly prohibited in the workplace. Use explosion-proof ventilation systems and equipment. Avoid generating dust. Avoid contact with oxidants and acids. Equip corresponding types and quantities of firefighting equipment and emergency response equipment for leaks. Empty containers may have residual harmful substances.
