## 4.1 Description of first aid measures

General advice

Consult a physician. Show this material safety data sheet to the doctor in attendance.

If inhaled

Carbon oxides are combustible. Beware of tempering. Vapor is heavier than air, so it can spread along the ground. In the event of a fire, hazardous gases or vapors may be generated. Forms explosive mixtures with air at moderate temperatures.
